**DESCRIPTION:**

The project supports the development of the National Policy for the Integrated Management of Water Resources, through monitoring the implementation of its 'Hydrological Plan' and by providing a favorable financing framework for investments in the water sector. The project also made contributions to environment protection, through the improvement of quality of water resources and increased water availability for the population.

**EXPECTED RESULTS:**

- Preserving 80% of key ecosystems for water resources.
- Characterizing and quantifying 60% of water demand.
- Improving water quality (i.e., reaching 70 % of quality indicators in priority watersheds).
- Studies for the strategic management plan of the major basins of the Orinoco, Pacific and Amazon rivers.
  - Priority river watersheds with a watershed committee.
  - Water users regularized on the priority river watersheds.
  - Watersheds that have implemented the tools for conflict management resolution.
  - Priority river watersheds that have implemented an integrated management plan including risk management.
- Implementation of the water resource management plan in the Pilot Project of Lago de Tota.
- Support for the rehabilitation of the facility of Salto del Tequendama.
