DESCRIPTION:

This program aims at financing priority wastewater projects in selected cities in Costa Rica. LAIF contributes with preparatory studies that will close a significant information gap and allow investments in improved wastewater infrastructure. The objective is to improve the environmental conditions and to create positive impacts in public health.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

- Preparatory studies and final design documentation.
- New or rehabilitated sewer pipes: 169 km.
- Wastewater treatment capacity: 59 900 m3/d.
- Population benefiting from improved sanitation services: 49 900 households.
- Wastewater treated: 162 600 population equivalents.
