The aim is to carry out complementary studies (e.g. preparation of project profiles, knowledge management, training), support the creation of new and innovative companies and strengthen the financial sector at the service of micro, small and medium-sized enterprises.

- Investment options of energy efficiency at selected water and sanitation systems: Wastewater Treatment Plant in Fortaleza and Gaviao Potabilization Plant – CAGECE.
